Greetings: Oriire fun owo! (Good Tidings to you!)

I pray that you are feeling awake, aware, and elevated in mind, body, and spirit wherever you are, and whatever may be happening around you! *A<u>se</u>! A<u>se</u>! A<u>se</u> o!*

I am *Baba Umar, Oluranse Emese,* (Voice of the Emese), *Member of the Isoro* Traditional Council of Chiefs, and *Babalawo* of *Ile Awo Ori<u>s</u>a*.

Thank you for joining us for another lesson in our Video Blog Series. Our topic in this video review from our September 2016 Blog Post is **Understanding Your** *Ori*.

- Your *Ori* is your Spiritual Master and the Manifestation of *Olodumare* that is attached to you.
- Your *Ori* is your Guide during your journey in the marketplace.
- It is your *Ori* that works to assist you in navigating towards the fulfillment of your Divine Destiny.
- *Ori* in the *Yoruba* language means head and in the language of *Ifa* it means more than your physical head.

This traditional *Ifa* saying highlights what should be understood about your *Ori*.

Ori inu wa maba tode je!

May our spiritual **Ori** not be in conflict with our physical **Ori**!

- Conflict between your physical *Ori* and your Spiritual *Ori* (*Ori Inu, Ori Apere*) can make you feel like a divided person, as though forces inside of you are pulling and pushing in different directions. (Cognitive Dissonance)
- You can feel a lack of fulfillment even when appearances would suggest that you should be content, even happy.
- You may have a feeling that there is still something missing in your life, something that remains to be done even though you have no idea what that something is.
- You might have a feeling like whatever that illusive something is, it is right there on the tip-of-your-tongue, or on the edge-of-your-thoughts but it just hangs there, unclear, just out of your reach.

Conflict between your Spiritual *Ori* and your physical *Ori* is a product of your identification with your **physical body**, your **intellectual mind**, your **analytical mind** or **left-brain**, your **egoistic persona**, and your **pain body** that arises from your negative experiences and socialization in the marketplace.

The conflict arises because your *Ori Inu* or *Ori Apere* is the **Carrier of your Destiny**, and when you come into the *L'oja*, **you tend to forget why you came**. That is part of the human condition, and an aspect of your journey in life – **you struggle to remember who you truly are, and why you really came**.

The *L'oja* (marketplace) is full of **temptations**, **distractions**, **delusions**, **illusions**, **tricks**, and **traps** that can entice your physical *Ori* to make decisions and choices that obstruct your progress towards the purpose for which you chose to come into the world. A **major roadblock** to your progress is the desire to seek the approval of other people and to follow the crowd.

The noise of the marketplace can drown out the messages that your *Ori Inu* (Spiritual *Ori*) is sending to you to assist you in staying On Path and fulfilling your chosen destiny. This messaging of your Spiritual *Ori* is a right-brain process, meaning mental activities and experiences like **meditation**, **trance**, **intuition**, **creativity**, **insight**, **higher consciousness**, etc.

Since the physical body is rooted in the physical world and your physical *Ori* is seated in or operates through the experiences of the physical body, it (your physical *Ori*) tends to be sensitive and responsive to all of the drives, appetites, and emotions of the body and the marketplace. But you and I did not choose to come into the world simply to satisfy and appease our own drives, appetites, and emotions. Creation has a higher purpose and so does your life. As it states in *Odu Ifa*,

"A wa gegebi Eniyan We as human beings A wa ni Olodumare yan We are the God's elect Lati lo tun ile aye se, Designated to renew the world, Eni-a yan ni wa." We are the Chosen Ones.

from Sacred Odu Irosu'wori (78)

It is your *Ori Inu*, your *Ori Apere* (Spiritual *Ori)* that is sensitive and responsive to the *Ase Orun* (the Spiritual Energies of Heaven). It is your Spiritual *Ori* that connects you to your *Eleda*, *Olorun's* righteous and observant presence in each of the *Eniyan* (human beings).

Since your Spiritual *Ori* and your physical *Ori* have different sensitivities and respond to different calls, you, the devotee must apply effort to bring your physical *Ori* into alignment with your Spiritual *Ori*. This is the purpose of mindfulness, prayer, ritual, ceremony, divination, and sacrifice.

In my last Post I offered you an *Adura* (a prayer) to your *Ori*. Let me invite you to go back to that Post and think about the words of that prayer in light of my comments in this Post. Also, consider these *Ifa* Proverbs:

Aye L'oja, Orun N'ile!

The world is the marketplace, The Spirit World is Home!

Ohun Ori wa se, Koma ni s alai se eo! Ile Awo Orisa What *Ori* comes to fulfill, It cannot but fulfill it!

Ka maa Worisha!

Let us keep looking to **Orisa**!

According to the *Ese Ifa* (the Sacred Text of *Ifa*) *Ori* is greater than any other god and each person should take all problems first of all to his or her own *Ori*. When a person goes to the *Babalawo*, Priest, or Priestess to consult *Ifa* all he or she is doing is finding out the wishes of her or his own *Ori*.

The role of the gods, according to *Ifa*, is to aid *Ori* in leading every person to his or her destiny in life. If a says: **Whatever a person's** *Ori* **has refused to approve, no other god can grant it**.

Hence, your **Ori** is the most important source of knowledge, wisdom, understanding, and guidance in your life. And deep meditation, trance, self-reflection, and **Ifa** divination are your primary methods of direct access to communicating with your Spiritual **Ori**.

Ki Olodumare, Orisa, ati Egun fifun e ni Itona, Imoye, ati Opo Ire!

My Olodumare, Orisa, and Ancestors bestow on you Guidance, Wisdom, and Abundant Blessings!

Ifokanbole! Peace of Mind from *Olodumare*! *Ajolo Ajobo!* We go out together; We return together! *A<u>se</u>! A<u>se</u>! A<u>se</u> o!*
